

# First Grade

Your child is expected to begin first grade having mastered:

## Numbers:

1. Read and write numerals to 100
2. Recognize word names to ten
3. Order and compare numbers 0-100
4. Count to 100 by 2's, 5's, and 10's
5. Use ordinal (order) positions and numbers first (1<sup>st</sup>) through tenth (10<sup>th</sup>)
6. Recognize and use arithmetic symbols +, -, ×, \$, and c

## Addition:

1. Add facts with sums to 10
2. Solve simple story problems involving addition
3. Recall from memory the basic addition facts with sums to 10

## Subtraction:

1. Subtract facts with minuends to 10.
2. Solve simple story problems involving subtraction
3. Recall from memory the basic subtraction facts with minuends to 10

## Fractions:

Recognize equal parts of an object or set  $\frac{1}{2}$ ,  $\frac{1}{3}$ ,  $\frac{1}{4}$

## Time:

1. Tell time to the hour and half-hour on circular and digital clocks
2. Name the days of the week in order
3. Name the months of the year in order

## Money:

1. Identify coins and currency-penny, nickel, dime, quarter, half dollar, dollar
2. Know the value of coins and dollars
3. Know the value of a set of coins

## Geometry:

Identify plane figures-circle, square, triangle, rectangle, cone, sphere, cube, and cylinder

## Letters:

1. Recognize all letters of the alphabet
2. Form all letters correctly
3. Copy words and letters correctly, including using the correct case (upper or lower)

**Letter Sounds:**

Identify beginning and ending sounds

**Reading and Vocabulary:**

1. Read on a second grade level
2. Recognize basic sight words
3. Recognize high fluency words and be able to read them quickly

**Sequence:**

Be able to repeat in sequence-letters, numbers, and events

**Attentiveness:**

1. Sit attentively when someone is speaking
2. Listen attentively to peers on a one-to-one basis, to speakers, and to others in small and large groups
3. Follow simple oral directions
